- Making a video takes too long - so many steps
- Editing software hard to learn, don't know techniques

I have all the cool cameras, lenses, bags and gadgets. I have TOO much of that stuff and I'm starting to realize it can be a distraction. Carrying TOO much can almost be as bad as not enough.

I've noticed that the gear has started to get in the way. Take video for instance. I shoot a great deal of video. I have all the cool video accessories known to man. But lately, I'm going out with a more bare bones set up and making great stuff.

It used to take me an hour to set up my gear. Now it takes about 15 min. That's 45 minutes more shooting time. I can shoot more if I bring less.

Don't Leave Home Without 'Em

- A camcorder for all occasions
- Extra batteries & charger
- Extra SD cards - Class 6
- Gorillapod(s) - ball-head ideal
- Voice recorder
- Coin, lens pen, remote, case or bag, small accessories

Along for the Ride

- Directional (external) microphone
- Extra lenses
- Monopod (walking stick), flexi-band
- Laptop and HD or thumb drive for backup
- Safe at home - tripod, light stand, BIG hard drive

Setting Your Sights

- Auto default - keep it simple, but check first
- White balance - can set in situ
- Image stabilization - not a panacea

Lights - Camera - Action

- Visualization - think in sequences
- Stabilization - steady as she goes
- Composition - frame & mix shots
- Movement - ready, aim, freeze
- Remember - you're on holiday

Visualization

- Storytelling - not always literal
- Shooting & editing are inseparable
- Imagine what comes before & after
- Think in sequences
- Recognize opening & closing shots

Stabilization

- Image stabilization not always effective
- Use 2 hands, elbows to chest, hold breath
- Long shots iffy - move closer
- Gorillapod, monopod, flexi-band
- Watch what you set it on



Composition

- Same rules of thumb as stills - but hard to crop
- You control - focal length, point of view, location, direction
- Variety - mix & duplicate shots, add B-roll
- Length of shots - 10 sec - extra at in & out
- Be careful out there - respect personal space
- Action axis - 180 degree rule - don't cross the line

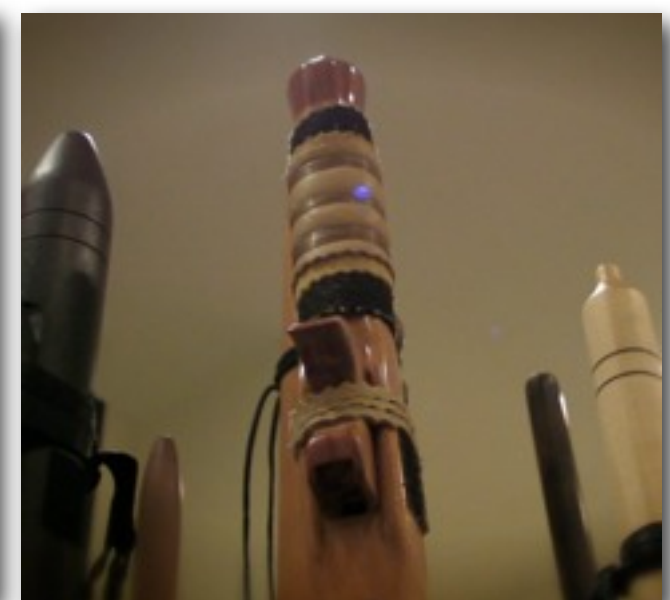

Movement

- The basic moves - pan, tilt, zoom, dolly, truck
- Handheld pan & zoom rarely work - better to avoid
- On tripod - pan S-L-O-W-L-Y. Pause - pan - pause.
- Too much motion drives audiences crazy
- Lock in and let the action come to you
- Start rolling - action starts - action - action stops - keep rolling

Workflow

- Get video off your camcorder ASAP!
- Preview your clips when you get home
- Import compressed video (AVCHD, mp4)
- At high quality, decompresses 6x or more
- iMovie excellent for selecting best clips fast
- Can export to .xml and open into Final Cut



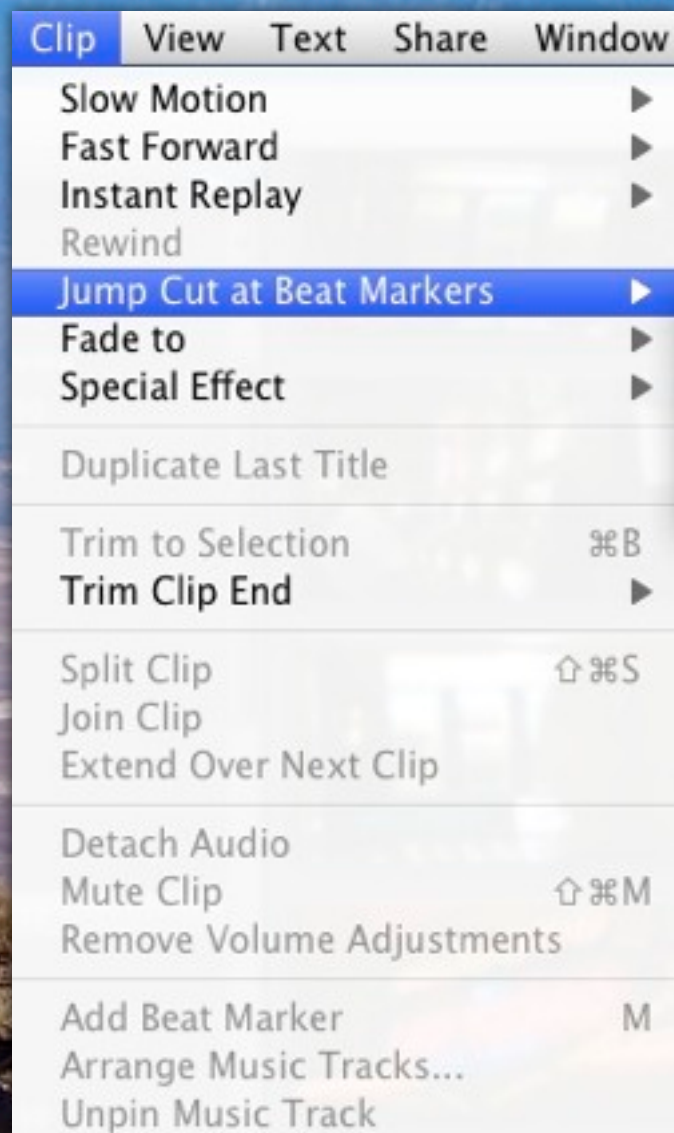
Story Time

- Not literal - “see” the story - tell it your way
- Style & mood - narrative, interview, music & FX
- Music can make or break your show - gotta ❤️ it
- Music & length of shots set pace
- 5 min is a good target - individual shots 4-5 sec

Editing Tips - Process

- Beginning & ending - drop in as bookends
- Start somewhere (anywhere) - build a sequence
- Reorder and bridge between sequences
- See the story - build whole storyline - any length
- Play rough cut to music choices - select the best
- Trim clips, edit length to music - drop clips of lesser value

Editing Tips - Cuts



- Continuity adds to cinematic illusion
- Combine variety of shots & angles
- Technique - cut on action
- Match movement between cuts
- Technique - avoid the jump cut

Editing Tips - Sound

- Music & effects set the tone for the whole show
- Garage Band or royalty free music on line
- Sound FX - part of iMovie or FC - more on line
- Technique - cut to the beat

Editing Tips - Sound

- Transitions - cross dissolve*, page peel, ripple, cross zoom, dip to black/white
- Titles, supers & lower thirds - pick right fonts
- Add stills and movement in place of video
