Foreign Booking Fees and Additional Payment Information: There is a foreign booking charge of \$60 per foreign residence (\$35 per Canadian residence). There is a \$25 charge for returned checks.

Air Add-ons: Airfare from most major cities is available through Holland America Line (HAL). You can call our office for this pricing. Please be advised: This cruise requires, in essence, booking two one-way tickets. It is likely, therefore, that the cruise line's airfare pricing will be comparable to, or better than, what you'll find on your own. However, it never hurts shop on your own. Online travel sites such as Expedia.com or Travelzoo.com are excellent resources. If you find better rates online, and if you then prefer to book with a "real" person (and get the same rates available via the online services), we recommend GTI (800-715-4440 or 800-716-4440, Agent PIN #54575) because of their 7-day a week office hours and their lowest-fare guaranteed service option ("Aircare Program").

Pre- and Post-cruise Hotel Stays: Sightsee Vancouver! The hotel will be close to the dock. If we book your Vancouver hotel, transfers from the hotel to the dock are included.

ALASKA DIGITAL CAMERA WORKSHOP

This workshop will cover the latest digital camera and printing technology in a fun and unique hands-on laboratory environment.

Join us on the first day as we show you the latest 3-, 4- and 5-megapixel digital cameras. We'll

cover how digital camera technology works as well as what the standard controls on a digital camera are including answering questions about your own camera(s). Towards the end of the first day we'll also cover the most common

shooting mistakes and show you how to handle and/or avoid them. At the end of the first session, we'll set you loose with a camera (if you didn't bring one of your own) to go shooting on the ship and in the Alaskan wilderness. The second day will focus on helping you get the best prints possible from your digital images. We'll take your pictures and show you the best ways to manipulate them in Photoshop including how to make color corrections, retouchings, and how to properly prepare your images for print. In the second half of the second day we'll give you a chance to try latest inkjet printers from Canon, Epson and/or HP and show you how to make your images look better than traditional photographs. We'll also include tips for unique software tools to enhance your pictures, and some recommendations for software that will let you find those images long after you've shot them.
