You will then head for the centre of Malaga where, as you sip on the local wine, you will be able to watch a thrilling and captivating flamenco show: this typically Spanish dance will overwhelm you with its sensuality, the intensity of the music and its unmistakable rhythm, leaving you an unforgettable memory of this city.

TOUR OF MALAGA

One of the most ancient ports in the Mediterranean Sea, Malaga is situated in the centre of an area of sub-tropical vegetation. Its impressive cathedral is one of the largest and most important buildings of the Andalusian Renaissance, and was begun in 1528 on the site of an ancient mosque. The town itself is attractive with its characteristic "calles" and tree-lined avenues. You will be enchanted admiring the beauty of the Alcazaba's architecture, the last defence of the Moorish resistance against the Christian kings and the largest Arabic monument in the city. The tour includes a stop in Gibralfaro, whose fortress dates back to the Phoenician period. From the ancient walls you can enjoy a wonderful view of the city, the bay and the outskirts.

Please note: Closing day for the Alcazaba is Monday. In the event of religious celebrations the visit of the cathedral will be an external view only.

FES

If we had to visit only one city of Morocco, our choice would fall on Fez for its architectural wealth, the fascinating medina, the magnificent monuments, as well as for its history that make Fez the cultural capital of the country. Religious, intellectual and artistic metropolis of Morocco, crib of a millennial monarchy, Fez was for a long time the political capital of the empire. After a journey by bus, crossing a pleasant country, we will reach Fèz. We will enter the medieval city through the monumental door Bab Bou Jeloud, decorated with maioliche enameled resplendent to the sun, we will find ourselves absorbed in a world where life stirs to rhythms by now unknown: the artisans work with skill using original tools, the women cook the bread in the public oven, the weavers they work on looms following gestures consolidated by a secular tradition, the donkeys, the only means of transport permitted inside the medina, commodities of every type are bought and sold. We will visit the Medersa Bouanania, wanted by the sultan Abou Inan, whose courtyard is marvelously realized in marble and onyx. A lunch of typical Moroccan dishes will be served inside the Mnebhi building, one of the more refined buildings of the Medina, from whose terrace we can admire the surrounding panorama. We will continue the visit with a walk through a labyrinth of alleys of the Medina, place of thousand discoveries and feelings, where every zone entertains a different guild of artisans: the souk Attarine, entirely devoted to the spices, the souk Nejarine, devoted to the carpenters, Place Seffarine, populated with blacksmiths shops, the dyers' souk where skeins of silk are hung to dry in the sun. We will explore together with our guide the most fascinating souk of Fèz, that of the conciatoris, announced by the strong and sharp odor of the hides. From a panoramic terrace we will see the extraordinary job and tradition of dyeing of the skins in the great tubs. We will pass in front of the Mausoleum of Moulay Idriss, founder of the millennial city of Fez, a place revered by the Moslems. Through the richly decorated principal wooden door, we can glimpse the room of prayer, with his/her innumerable chandeliers and an amazing collection of clocks, among which two splendid clocks given by Luigi XIV, the King Alone. We will pass close to the Mosque Kairouyine, founded in the destination' of the IX century, also centre of a famous university' defined as the most ancient in the world. The building is closed to the non Moslems, but from it's numerous doors we can glimpse some of the precious treasures. We will leave the medieval city passing the fortitude Saadita of Borj Nord, here we have a photo opportunity to capture the whole and mysterious Medina. Before leaving again to return to Casablanca, we will cross the Jewish district of Mellah, stopping in front of the

Royal Building.

Please note: The duration of the excursion will be approx. 13 hours of which 8 hours approx. will be on the coach. There will be lots of walking therefore we suggest comfortable shoes. The limited areas inside Souk can have short queues of tourists especially on the leather-tanning terrace. Space is limited, so please book early. This excursion is not recommended for people with walking difficulties. The order of the itinerary may vary.

MEKNES

We leave Casablanca in a north east direction arriving at Meknes, in the middle of fertile and prosperous plains along the Bokefrane River. It was the Capital of Moulay Ismail, a Sultan of the Louis XIV period, who wanted Meknes full of great monuments. We will admire the ramparts and bastions broken up by splendid gates, like the 'Bab Monsour' one, called the 'Victorious Gate' the entrance of honour to the imperial city. Afterwards, we will visit the Sultans Grain Store, huge buildings dating back to the 18th century, where food was stored. We will then admire the Mosque and the Mausoleum of Moulay Ismail, where you will see refined marble decorations and hand painted symbols on precious cedar wood. We will also stop at the Dar Al Jamaii Museum - the Museum of Moroccan Art - and at 'La Medersa Bou Inania' a Coran School of the 15th century, in the heart of the Old Medina. Here it is possible to admire the incredible variety of the typical handicraft products, giving you the perfect opportunity to take home a souvenir of an unforgettable day. A selection of typical Moroccan dishes will be served for lunch.

Please note : The excursion lasts approximately 13 hours, 8 of which are spent on the coach. There will be lots of walking therefore we suggest comfortable shoes. For the visit to the Moulay Ismail Mosque, shoes must be removed. Space is limited, so please book early. On Tuesdays the visit to the Dar Al Jamaii Museum will be replaced with the one to the Underground Prison.

Leaving Casablanca we will drive to Rabat, an ancient city and administrative capital of Morocco. TOUR OF CASABLANCA, HASSAN II MOSQUE AND RABAT

This tour will introduce you to Casablanca and Rabat, both fine examples of modern urban development which nevertheless retain all the characteristic atmosphere of Moroccan cities. The itinerary begins with a drive along the Boulevard de la Résistance towards the Royal Palace (external visit) and the Palace of Justice with a stop at the market. A must see along the way is the new and highly acclaimed Hassan II Mosque, a magnificent and astonishing monument. Upon leaving Casablanca, the tour moves on to Rabat. The tour of Rabat includes an external view of the Royal Palace, a splendid imitation of the highest examples of Islamic architecture; Mechouar, the mausoleum of Mohammed V; and the Hassan Tower. The tour stops for lunch at a restaurant, before continuing through Medina and the Kasbah of the Oudayas. The tour also includes a brief stop at a bazaar or at a typical Berber pharmacy.

Please note: Appropriate clothing is recommended to enter places of worship access to. Shoulders and knees must be covered while visiting the mosque. Shoes must be removed. In case of religious celebrations or holidays, the tour will visit but not enter the Hassan II Mosque. In the event of religious celebrations or national holiday the visit of the mausoleum Mohammed V will be an external view only. Space is limited, so please book early. The order of the itinerary may vary

Casablanca
MARRAKECH

Marrakech, chief town of the homonym province and the city that, for a long time has embodied the "Moroccan dream" of the most curious and romantic travelers. Situated at the feet of the tall Atlas mountains, in a fertile region, and the most famous imperial city of Morocco. Arriving from Casablanca, we will leave the bus near the medieval bastions of Marrakech to proceed in on foot into the ancient city: the Medina. Our guide will lead us on foot to the Mosque of the Koutoubia (or of the booksellers), erected in the XII century and so named because in years gone by the shops of book merchants surrounded it's walls. From it's imposing and stupendous minaret, masterpiece of the Hispanic-Moorish art, the muezzin calls the inhabitants of the city every day to prayer. Lunch gives us an opportunity to relax and to taste some food typical of the local kitchen. We will then continue our walk exploring the Bahia building, founded toward 1880 by the visir Ba Ahmed, Prime Minister of the sultan of Marrakech. We will admire the sumptuous building, a true masterpiece of Moroccan art, of such architectural charm it has featured in and set the ambience of films such as: Ali Baba and the 40 thieves, The lion of the desert and Casablanca. We will enter one of the Medina, with our guide and meander some of it's thousands of alleyways which swarm with frantic activity we will discover the "riad", the ancient Moroccan main residences from the luxuriant courtyards, that, with their original architectures and the refined decoration, make Marrakech a city' of incomparable charm. We will be surprised and fascinated by the colored walls, that have witness the life of the Medina for many years. We will pass near a Fondouk, an ancient hotel used by merchants, before continuing to the Medersa Ibn Youssef, one of the great est Koranic schools of Morocco, founded in 1565 and able to entertain up to 400 students and teachers. Decorated in plaster, mosaic and inlays of cedar wood, the building still maintains intact its great structure which is similar to a monastery. Transiting through the historic Talaa plaza, we will admire from the outside the mosque Ibn Youssef. From here we will walk in the colourful and perfumed world of the souks of Marrakech. In the lanes covered with reeds and lanterns a wealth of local handcraft are shown. From the blacksmiths' souk to the souk of the babouches and the souk Semmarine where we will be able' to admire the coloured universe of the braid. We will see an unimaginable selection of spices, fruit's, typical sweets and olives. We will come, finally, to the most famous plaza in Morocco, the Jemaa plaza el Fna, here we will find a colourful crowd of dancers, cantastorie, snake charmers and monkey trainers. The pulsating heart of the whole city', the site was proclaimed a "Masterpiece of the oral and immaterial patrimony of the humanity' by UNESCO in 2001". Marrakesh will leave you with a lasting image of Morocco as a fascinating and interesting country.

Please note: the excursion will take approximately 13 hours, 7/8 of which make up the coach trip. There will be lots of walking therefore we suggest comfortable shoes. The order of the itinerary may vary. The excursion is not recommended for people with walking difficulties. There will be a stop for some shopping in a typical Berber pharmacy before getting back on the bus for Casablanca.

TOUR OF CASABLANCA, HASSAN II MOSQUE

Casablanca, founded in 1515 by the Portuguese, is now an expanding and dynamic metropolis, with wide avenues lined by modern buildings of typical European style. Our tour starts along the Boulevard de la Résistance towards the Royal Palace (outside only) and the Law Courts. In this part of the city we will be able to view the typical handicraft shops and the picturesque olive market. The excursion then proceeds to the Habous Quarter, the Church of Notre Dame de Lourdes and the beautiful Mohammed V Square. You'll then visit the mosque of Hassan II, second in its size only to the Mecca. To complete the tour, you'll enjoy a drive along the panoramic coastal road (the Corniche). On this drive you will cross the residential quarter of Anfa and Ain Diab, a tourist area with splendid swimming pools hidden among the rocks, and lots of restaurants, bars and nightclubs. A typical shopping stop will end our excursion.

Please note: Appropriate clothing is recommended for access to the holy places. Shoulders and knees must be covered while visiting the mosque. In case of religious celebrations or holidays, the tour will visit but not enter the Hassan II Mosque.

CASABLANCA BY NIGHT

We will leave the port of Casablanca, dynamic cosmopolitan city, economic capital of Morocco, for a panoramic tour by bus crossing the modern suburbs built from the beginning of the 20th century according to an urbanistic plan destined to transform the city and to plan its extraordinary development. We will make a stop to take of a photos and our guide will show us Mohamed V square, the nerve centre of the city and modern Muslim architectural complex inspired by national traditions. Already the first shades of the evening, the water from the magnificent fountain creates a fascinating effect of sounds and lights. We will cross by bus the park of the Arabic League and we will go along the boulevard Moulay Youssef, one of the biggest arteries of the city, lined with elegant houses inspired by Art Deco and Neo Moorish Art. From there we will reach the largest mosque in the World second only to Mecca, Hassan II Mosque which according to the intentions of the King symbolizes an Islam open to the rest of the World and sciences. Hassan II Mosque is an astonishing master piece of art and technology, with its monumental minaret standing 200 metres high. Our itinerary will continue crossing the largest streets in the city centre and our guide will point out to us the Casablanca Twin Centre, a huge post modern complex made up of twin towers 100 metres high separated by colossal marble steps. We will then return to the sea shore and will proceed through the famous Corniche where we will see the prestigious hotels, here we will find our restaurant. We can not help being seduced by the atmosphere of authentic charm and romance, a sensual experience, this Moroccan interior where nothing is left to chance. Candles placed everywhere and hand painted decorations on the walls dating back to old times but still rich in charm today, produce a very intimate atmosphere and you will relax to the rhythm created by a fountain decorated by thousands of colours. The aromas and tastes of authentic local cuisine served to you in Limoges porcelain

dishes, the secret of which is to be found in the union of sweet and salty and in the delicate use of spices and aromatic herbs. Our dinner will be accompanied by Arab Andalusian musical notes and by a traditional dance. Of course our dinner would not be complete if we didn't sample to mint tea, a symbol of the Moroccan hospitality. We will board our bus again and cross the Corniche with its nightlife and return to the ship, after having admired once again Hassan II Mosque now illuminated in an atmospheric glow of light and you will understand why the inhabitants of Casablanca call this Mosque, with great pride, a "divine creation on the ocean!" Please note: Space is limited, so please reserve early.

TOUR OF SEVILLE

Seville, situated on the vast and fertile plain on the left bank of the Guadalquivir River, is the capital of Andalusia and an elegant city thanks to its traditions, feasts and fine Arab and Christian monuments. The tour includes a visit to the vast Gothic Cathedral, which houses many priceless treasures and the tomb of Christopher Columbus. You will see the impressive Barrio de Santa Cruz, the Jewish quarter in the Arab epoch, with very intricate alleys, squares, adorned with flowers and many patios and the Alcazar, a building of medieval shape which was built during the second half of the 14th century and designed by Arab architects. After lunch you will continue to Plaza de España, surrounded by the opulent pavilions, arranged in a semicircle, of the Ibero-American Exposition of 1929. Here you will have the chance to take a few photographs of the square or stroll through the Parque de Maria Luisa, a large park donated to the city by the Infanta Maria Luisa Fernanda de Borbon, before returning to Cadiz.

Please note: The visit to the Alcazar and its gardens includes approximately 2 1/2 hours of walking. On Mondays and on the occasion of special events the visit of the Alcazar will be substituted by the visit of the Pilato House. Appropriate clothing is recommended to enter places of worship.

JEREZ CELLARS AND ARCOS DE LA FRONTERA

This tour will make guests discover the secrets of the famous sherry land of the province of Cádiz which produces the world-wide known Jerez Wine. Before that, the tour will start with a panoramic drive of the city of Cádiz while the guide will point out the most important monuments and places of the city such as the Constitution Monument and the Beautiful Cathedral. After this, buses will head directly to Arcos de la Frontera. Arcos sits along a ridgeline above the impressive cliff, Peña Nueva, overlooking the winding Guadelete River and its broad valley. The opposite side of the ridge, Peña Vieja, overlooks Lago de Arcos. The old town center sits at the highest point, with streets of white-washed homes cascading down the ridgeline. Motor traffic flows only west to east into the old town, then loops back, leaving the town's labyrinth to be explored peacefully on foot. The guide will point you out the most important venues in the village as: Plaza Cabildo, and peer from the plaza's open north side down onto the golden cliffs and out across the river plain. The old Castillo (fort) and Santa Maria church overlook the square, along with one of Spain's better Paradors (state-operated historic inns). After this, the bus will take the road to Jerez de La Frontera, a town placed only 50 kilometers away from the sea and Cádiz, but with a so different climate that makes possible to cultivate the different types of grape that produce the three main different Sherry varieties. Once buses arrives to Jerez, guests will visit the cellars or bodega as they are called. At the cellars, guests will follow the explanations of the process to create the original sherry wine from the grape cultivation until the liquor is put into the bottle and they will have the chance to have an unlimited sherry tasting. Once finished back to the ship.

A STROLL THROUGH LISBON

You will start your journey by taking a bus to the Baixa (downtown) with its main square Praça da Figueira and Rossio, the centre of life in Lisbon. First stop will be a visit to the Square of Commerce, thought by many to be the most beautiful square in Europe. A walk will take you to the Elevador da Gloria. This funicular makes the connection between the Praça dos Restauradores and the Bairro Alto or High Quarter. The ride spans approximately 265 metres and takes approximately five minutes, leaving you at the São Pedro de Alcantara Belvedere, with stunning views over the city, really giving you an idea of the feeling Lisbon conveys, with views over the tiled rooftops of the city. After you will be invited to enjoy a glass of Port wine at Solar do Vinho do Porto. From the Solar, a short walk will take you to the magnificent São Roque Church. As you visit the interior you will marvel at the beautiful painted wood ceiling, and the renowned chapel by Luigi Vanvitelli honouring St. John the Baptist. The church was founded by the Jesuits in the late 16th century, while Vanvitelli's chapel was ordered by King João V in 1741, assembled in Rome from precious materials, such as alabaster and lapis lazuli, dismantled, shipped to Lisbon and reassembled in its current location.

SINTRA AJUDA PALACE AND LISBON

TREASURES OF ART AND POPULAR CULTURE

Your discovery of Valencia will begin at the Cathedral, better known to Valencians as "La Seu", or "The Seat", which still represents the heart of the religious, cultural and daily life of the city. Building began in 1262 in a Gothic-Cistercian style, and carried on into the 18th century; the result is the harmonious mix of different styles to be found today. Under one of the doorways every Thursday the famous "Tribunal de Las Aguas" (Water Court), the oldest legal institution in Europe, is held. Justice is dispensed on the spot concerning arguments over the irrigation of Valencia's fertile plain. But it is in the Cathedral that you will find the most jealously guarded, ancient and venerated Christian relic: the Holy Chalice that Christ used in the celebration of the last supper. From the sacred to the profane: you will then head for the Lonja, the old silk exchange, one of the most fascinating pure Gothic civil buildings in history. Across the road you will have the chance to take a look at the one of the largest covered markets in Europe covering over 8,000 square metres with around a thousand outlets. Glass cupolas, art nouveau iron finishings, brightly coloured tiles ("azulejos") form the backdrop to the incredible colours and aromas of the stalls. A taste of tradition, and some biting satire, await you in the

"Museo Fallero" with its "fallas" (papier-mâché figures), real monuments expertly crafted by people from the various districts of the city, who work all year round to help organise and bring the city's most important Festival to life.

BARCELONA AND LA SAGRADA FAMILIA

The first destination on the excursion will be La Sagrada Familia, icon and symbol of the city of Barcelona and a landmark for visitors from all over the world, often considered to be one of the most extraordinary monuments ever constructed by man. It is an imposing neo-Gothic church, designed using the great medieval cathedrals as models of reference, and constructed in a modernist style (the Catalan version of Art Nouveau). The project and its realisation was entrusted to renowned architect Antoni Gaudi (just over thirty years of age at the time), who worked on it for the rest of his life. Having begun in 1882, work still continues today following the

plans laid down by its designer: the fact that you'll be able to watch one of the masterpieces of world architecture being constructed before your very eyes will make your visit even more fascinating. Your guide will show you the two completed facades (the Nativity and the Passion facades) and will then lead you inside the church where expert craftsmen continue to work on a masterpiece in constant evolution. Next it's on to Park Guell, another of genius Gaudi's incomplete works: conceived at the beginning of the 1900's as a futuristic residential district, at the time the project failed to achieve the success that had been hoped for and work was interrupted. Yet Gaudi had fortunately already begun work on an inimitable project, with its wide winding pathways, benches and sculptures with multicoloured mosaics in pure modernist style. Your visit will conclude with a trip to Casa Mila, better known as "La Pedrera" ("the quarry"): this building undeniably represents Gaudi's most mature work and is distinctive for its myriad of revolutionary and visionary details, true testament to his extraordinary creativity.

TOUR OF BARCELONA

Barcelona's historical and cultural traditions, its monuments and mild climate make it one of the liveliest and most attractive cities in Spain. GAUDI'S MASTERPIECES

This trip will take you to the highly original Guell Park. Gaudi initially envisaged this area as a large English-style park, but successively its creation was largely entrusted to one of his disciples, Josep Maria Jujol. Its undulating benches covered in ceramic fragments of many shapes and colours are fascinating objects, whose numerous details and shades will certainly catch your eye. You will have time to stroll along the paths of this marvellous park, before boarding your coach for the short trip to "Eixample" district, where the famous "Sagrada Familia" (outside visit only) cathedral is situated. A local guide will give you a detailed commentary of the details of the façade. Finally, you will have some free time, as many of you will certainly be tempted to do some shopping. Your next stop will be Casa Mila, better known as "La Pedrera" (The Stone Quarry), which certainly represents Gaudi's most mature work. No other building could better represent Modernism. This was the last residential building to be designed by Gaudi and was built between 1906 and 1912. It is characterised by a myriad of revolutionary details, which testify to the artist's creativity and extraordinary technical mastery. The next masterpiece on your itinerary is Casa Batllo, a residential building that exudes dreamlike atmosphere. You will be able to admire its façade, which is completely covered in a multicoloured mosaic of shiny scales. The same technique has been used for the roof. The suggestive façade recalls the legend of Saint George and his fight with the dragon: according to this reading, the cross can be interpreted as the tail of the dragon and the row of balconies as the bones of its victims. On your way back to the ship you will cross the commercial heart of the old city and of Barcelona itself - the famous Plaza de Catalunya - and the harbour area.

BARCELONA TO THE RHYTHM OF FLAMENCO

Next you will visit the "Pueblo Español", a village built in 1929 to represent an ideal model of "Pueblo Iberico", which features replicas of around 116 buildings, squares and streets from all over Spain. It also has large areas dedicated to Spanish art and crafts, where you can purchase all kinds of goods. The Andalusian quarter features the "Tablao de Carmen", named after the great dancer Carmen Amaya, where you will enjoy a flamenco show, admiring the dance that best represents the Spanish soul.

TOUR OF GENOA

As the coach drives past the port, you will be able to admire the Lanterna lighthouse, still a landmark for seafarers, before continuing to the most interesting parts of the city. On arriving to Castelletto one of the most ancient blocks, which is raised above the city. ALBISSOLA & SAVONA

In the handcraft ceramic shop you can admire and get acquainted with the different traditional decorations: old Albissola in blue and white, Ligurian "mezzaro" with its delicate colours, you will also find some modern decorations such as Paul Klee drawings. After making a panoramic tour of Savona by bus, we will meet in the centre and continue our journey by foot, visiting the Pinacoteca Civica. Here you will be able to see sculptures, paintings and ceramics from the 16th - 20th century. For guests who do not wish to visit the Pinacoteca, you will be able to enjoy free time in the city before returning onboard.

On Via Garibaldi, a real open-air museum, you will have the chance to visit the three most precious gems that house the city's artistic masterpieces: Palazzo Bianco, with paintings by Van Dyck, Caravaggio and Rubens, Palazzo Rosso, with its splendid interiors and paintings by Veronese and Guercino, and finally Palazzo Doria Tursi, with its magnificently furnished public rooms and the Paganini Museum, which still houses the violin that belonged to the famous maestro. At our last stop, in the Palazzo Rosso terrace, we will have the opportunity to sample a typical genovese favorite: focaccia accompanied by a glass of white wine.
