### Dress Code

Proper golf attire is required at all clubs. Shirts must have collars and sleeves, and shorts Bermuda length. No jeans, gym shorts or cut-offs allowed.

### Tee Time Reservation

Bermuda Government golf courses (Port Royal, Ocean View and St. George's Golf Club) have a centralised, automated Tee Time Reservation System. Advance bookings available for up to one year in advance via e-mail, fax or phone. For private golf courses it is necessary to arrange starting times in advance through hotel and guest house managements.

### Credit Cards

Credit cards are accepted for all charges at most courses. MasterCard and VISA are accepted by all eight courses and the Bermuda Golf Academy; American Express is accepted by most. Confirm when making your tee time arrangements.

### Special Charges for Golfing Equipment on Airlines

Airlines differ regarding policies on golf bags; some include them in the free baggage allowance and some charge a special flat rate. Enquire in advance with the airline concerned.

### Groups and Tournament Play

Most courses will accommodate groups if the Director of Golf or golf club management is notified well in advance. However, special group greens fees are not normally available. If your group is playing a tournament in Bermuda, you are eligible to receive local prizes, compliments of the Bermuda Department of Tourism, provided arrangements are made in advance. Minimum group qualification: 20 players.

### Golf Carts

Use of golf carts (electric or gas) is mandatory at Belmont Hills Golf Club, Fairmont Southampton and Riddell's Bay golf clubs, and on weekends and public holidays only at Port Royal, Ocean View and St. George's golf courses. Only adults may hire or drive a golf cart.

### Golf Clubs

Ladies' and men's right and left handed sets available at each golf course.

### Golf Balls

\$40 – \$55 per dozen (priced slightly higher in club pro shops).

### Caddies

Caddies available at Mid Ocean Club only.

### Reseeding Greens


Usually during late September to early November. Check with the hotel or golf club during this period to determine what conditions might exist.
