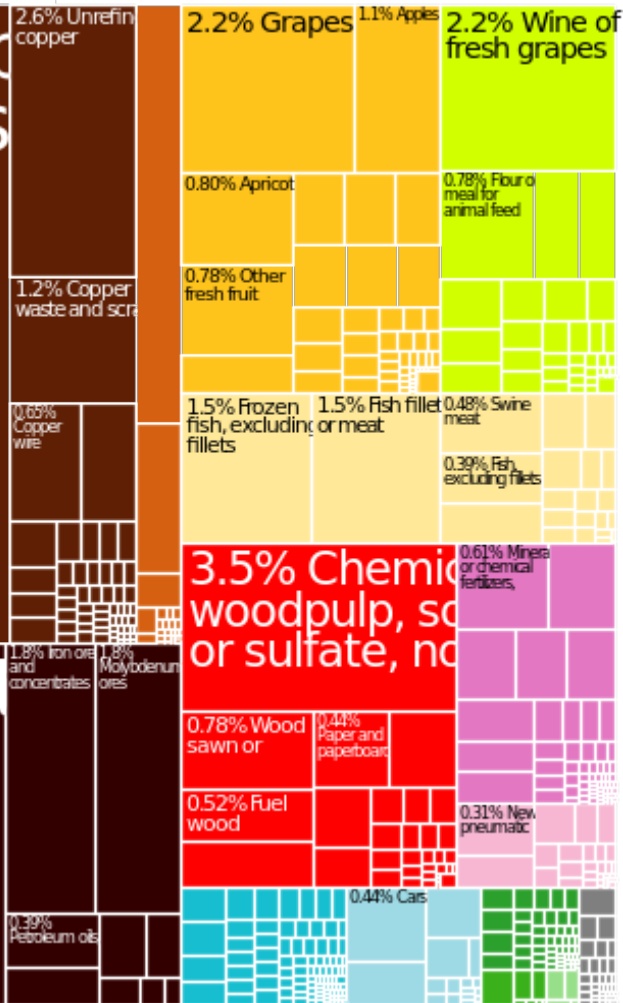

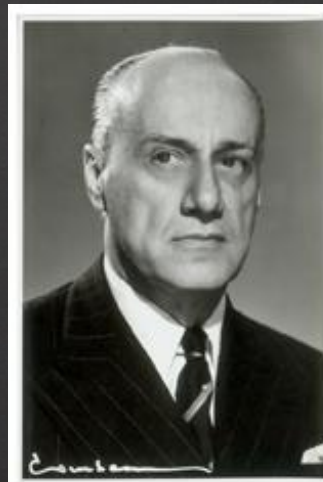

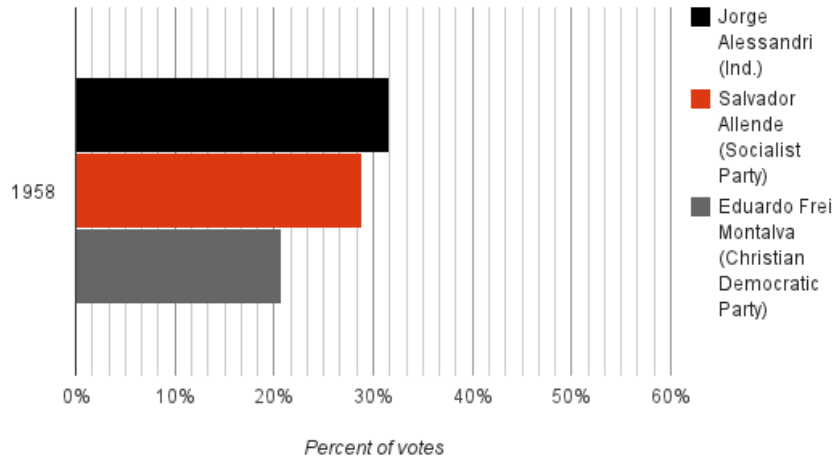

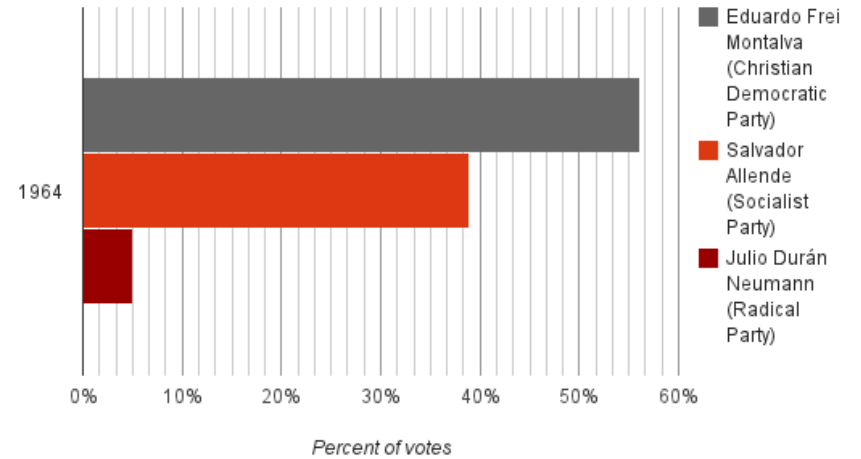

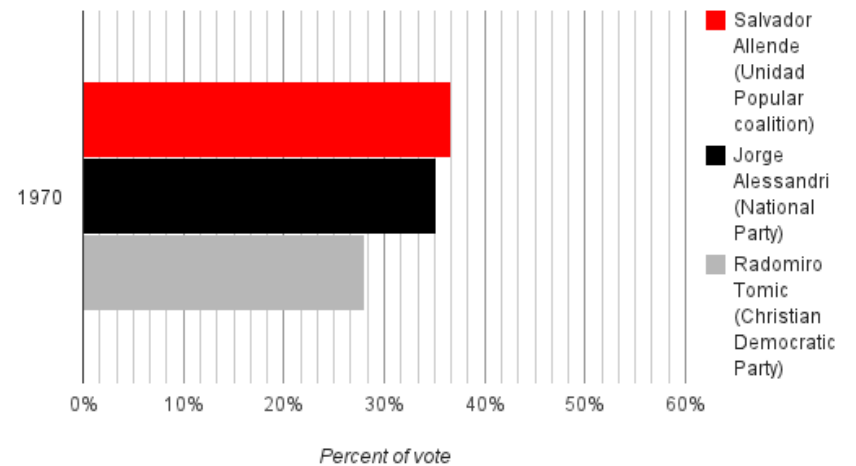
Chile electoral data, pres. election 1958

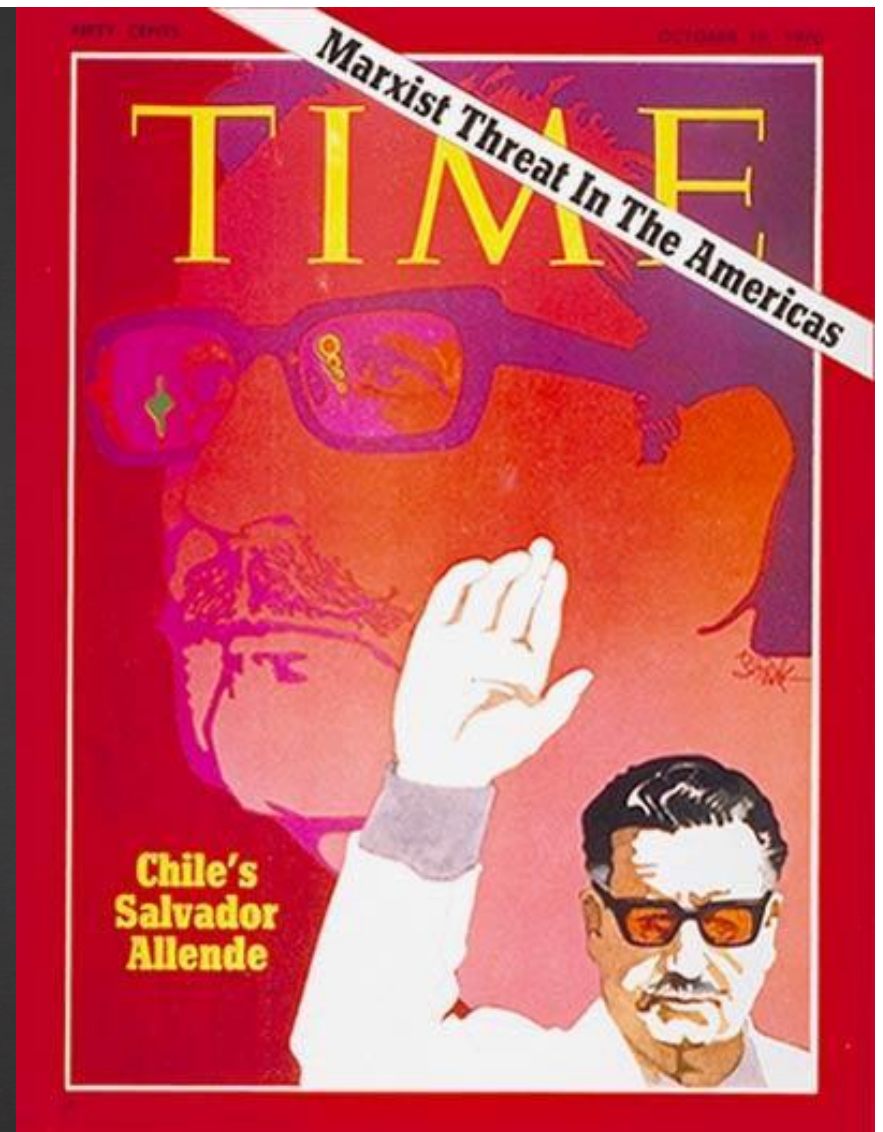

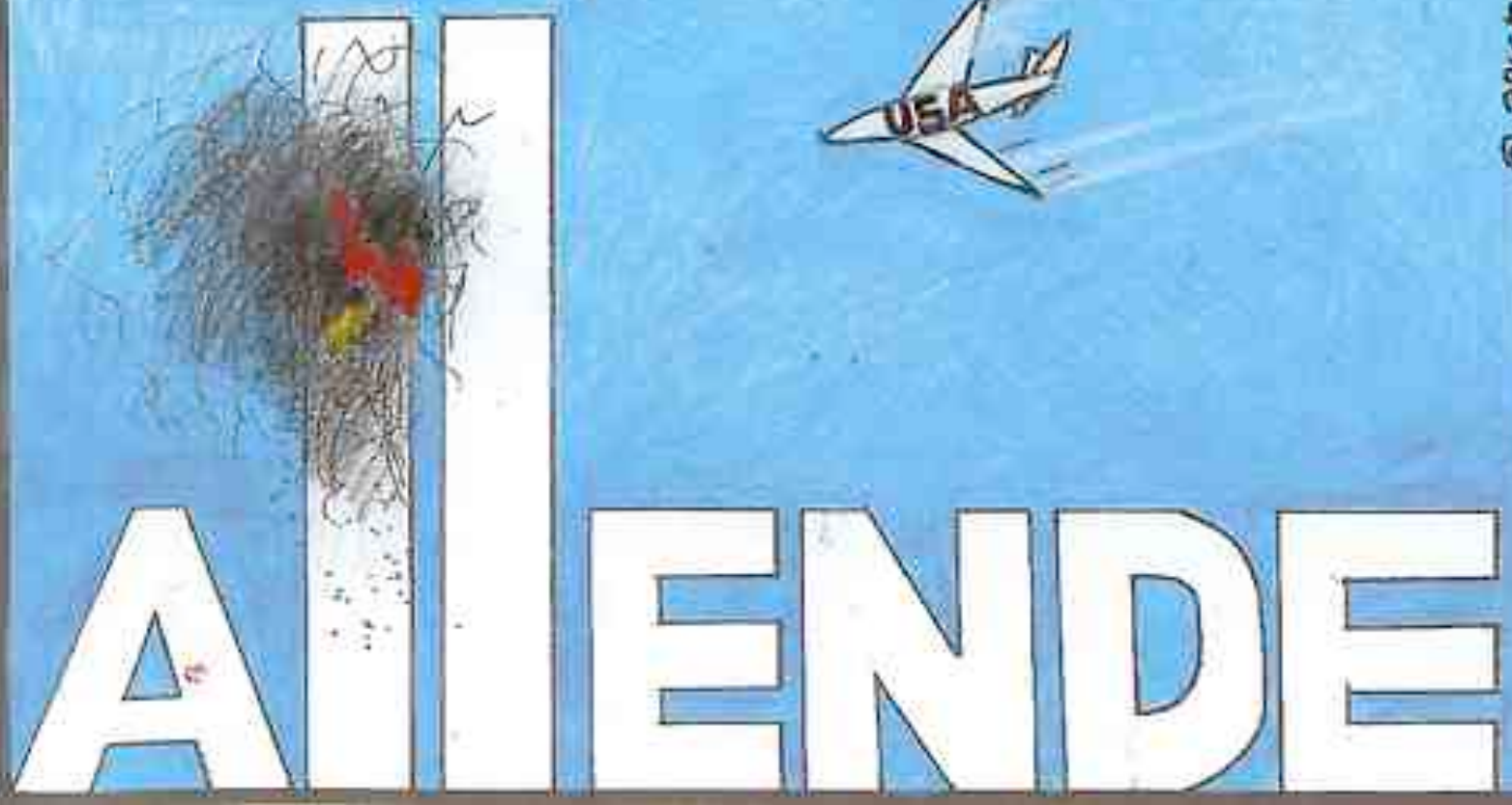

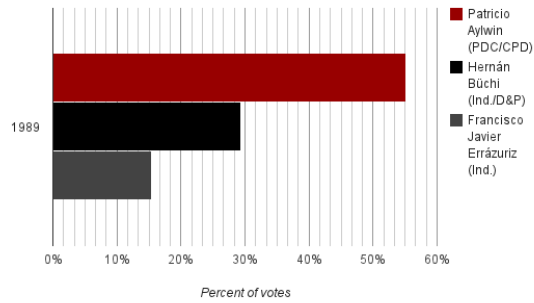

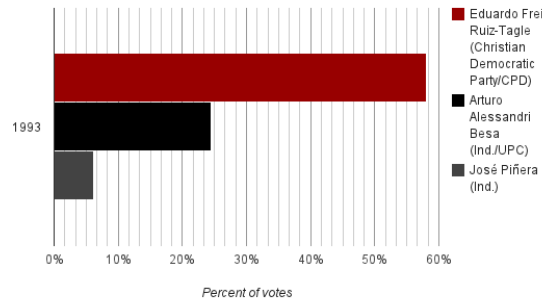

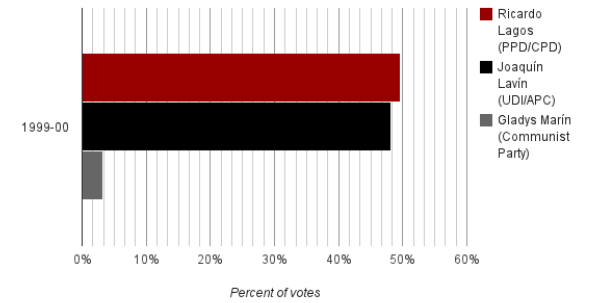
Chile electoral data, pres. election 1989



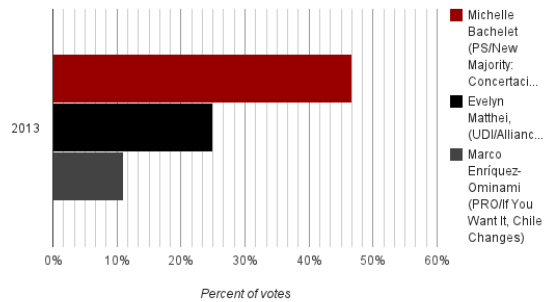
Chile electoral data, pres. election 1993



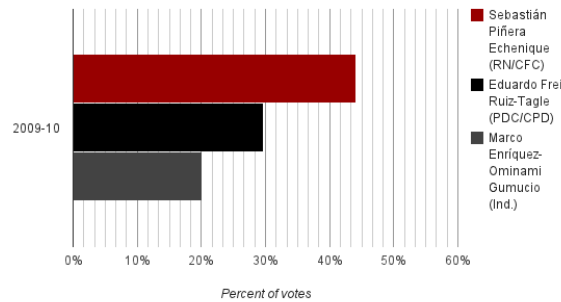
Chile electoral data, pres. election 1999-00 (general + runoff averaged)



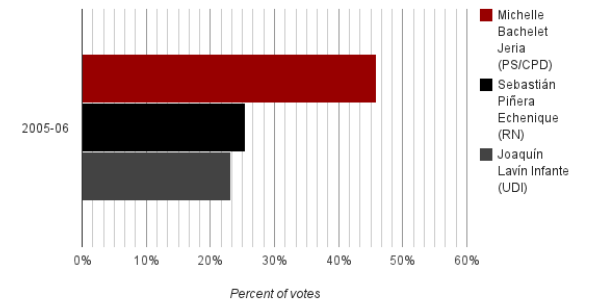
Chile electoral data, pres. election 2013 (general only)

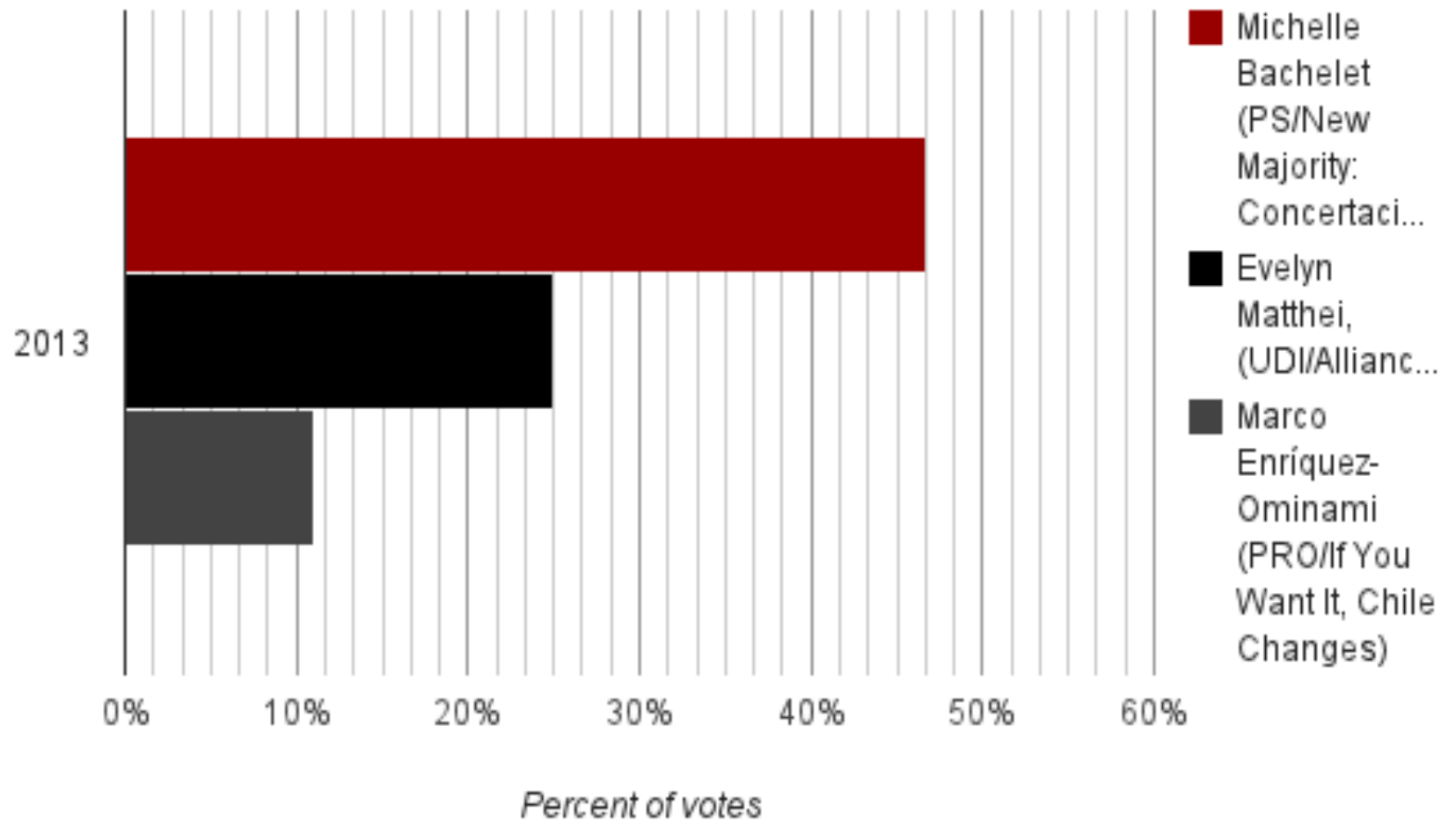
