never know, on the basis of actual observations. Light has a finite speed (1 light-year per year, or 300,000 kilometers per second), and there is only a finite time since the Big Bang. As we look out into space, we are also looking backward in time. Since the Big Bang occurred approximately 14 billion years ago, there is an absolute limit to how far we can peer in the universe.³⁸ What we see is a relatively homogeneous collection of galaxies, about 100 billion of them all told, steadily expanding away from one another. But outside our observable patch, things could be very different.

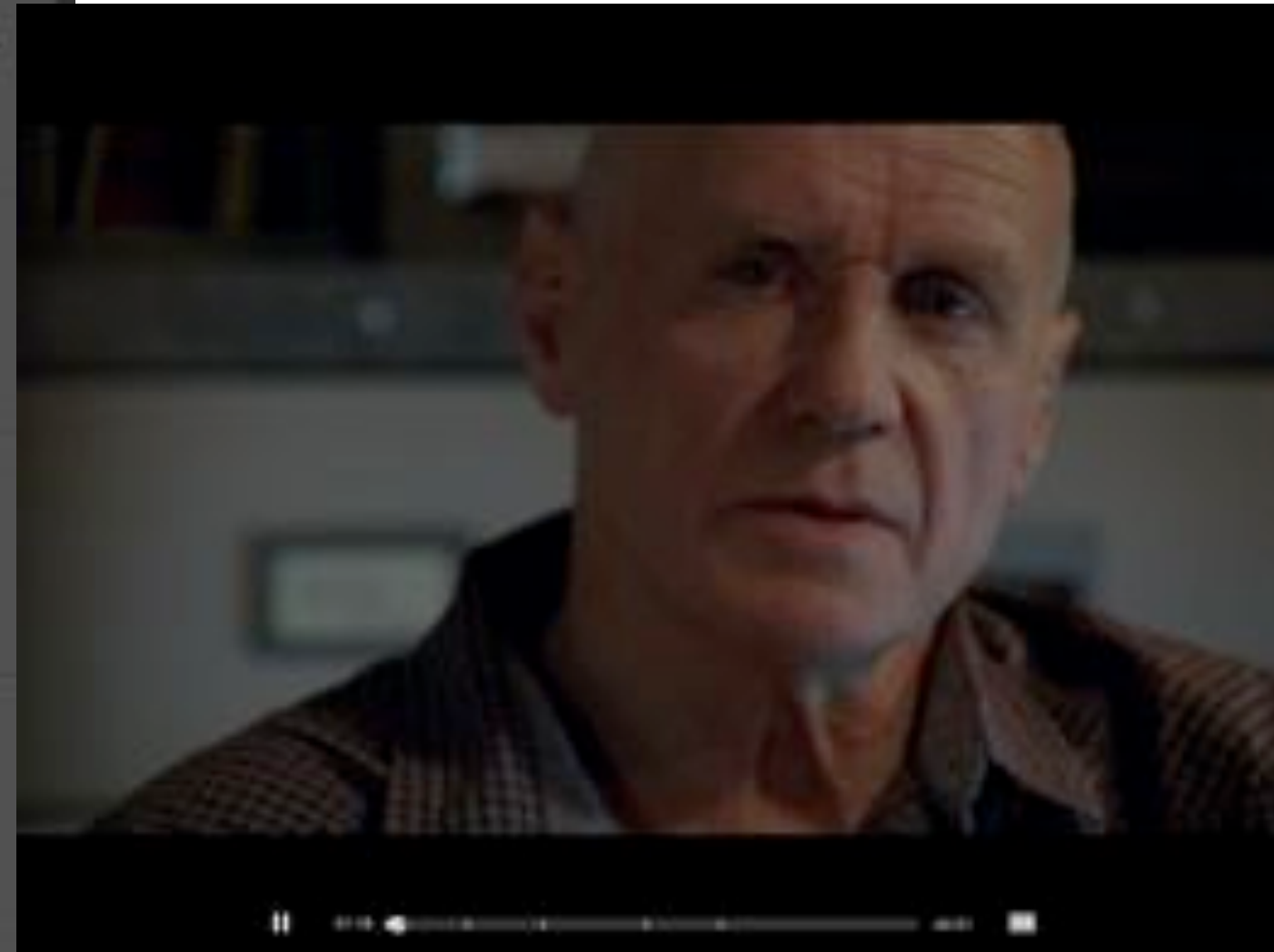

Bermuda

Bermuda (pronounced */bɜːrˈmjuːdə/*; officially, the **Bermuda Islands** or the **Somers Isles**) is a British overseas territory in the North Atlantic Ocean. Located off the east coast of the United States, its nearest landmass is Cape Hatteras, North Carolina, about 1,030 kilometres (640 mi) to the west-northwest. It is about 1,350 km (840 mi) south of Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada, and 1,770 km (1,100 mi) northeast of Miami, Florida. Its capital city is Hamilton.

Bermuda is the oldest and most populous remaining British overseas territory, settled by England a century before the Acts of Union created the Kingdom of Great Britain. Bermuda's first capital, St George's, was settled in 1612 and is the oldest continuously inhabited English town in the Americas.

Bermuda has a very affluent economy, with finance as its largest sector followed by tourism, giving it the world's highest GDP per capita in 2005. It has a subtropical climate.

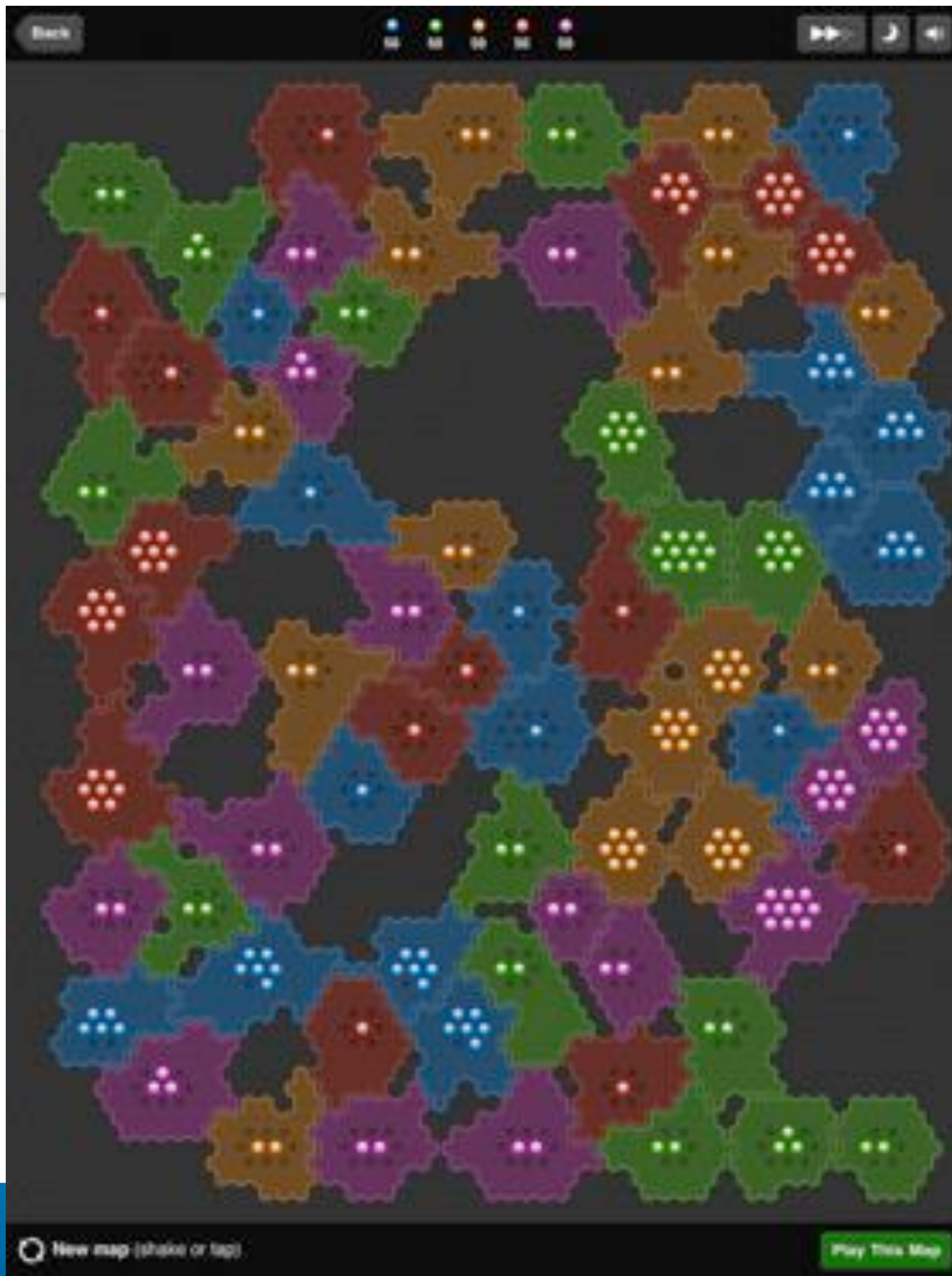
